GENERAL INFORMATION

Each participating team will submit the following documents to the Organizing Secretary/registration committee through mail on or before 12th Sept 2024 and hard copy on arrival at the campus.

- i) The team photo with the principal and photograph of the Coach/Manager in the given format must be duly attested by the principal.
- ii) Online participant's entry Performa must be sent through email: - sports@aisedu.org
- iii) Eligibility Performa filled online countersigned by the principal with school seal.
- iv) CBSE registration number for the students studying class IX and above.
- v) To provide original documents for verification. (If asked for)
- vi) In case of girl's participants, one of the accompanied officials must be a female.
- vii) Each participating school will bring its respective school flag for the March Past during the Opening Ceremony.
- viii) Please refer Rules of Sports and Games (2024-25) by CBSE, for necessary guidance.

DISCIPLINE

- 1.** All the participants of the team and their in-charges will be under the administrative control of the Principal and the Organizing Secretary of the organizing school. They will be governed by the rules and regulations of the school / CBSE.
- 2.** Indiscipline on the part of any team or its members will lead to disqualification and the team /member may be debarred from the Competition and will be asked to leave the campus immediately. The team Manager shall be responsible for the conduct of the team on the ground and the school campus.
- 3. Participants should not bring jewellery or any other expensive items/gadgets on the campus during the tournament.** Any item misplaced will be the sole responsibility of the individual the organising school will not take any responsibility of the same.
- 4. Outstation participants will keep all their belongings in their designated rooms under lock and key.**
- 5.** The players, coaches, and managers are expected to strictly adhere to the Rules and Regulations and Spirit of Sportsmanship and maintain a healthy sporting atmosphere during the tournament.

Any unfair and unwarranted behaviour from anyone concerned may invite suspension from the tournament.
- 6. All the Participating Schools will submit a Security Deposit of Rs2000/- on reporting which will be refunded upon departure.** Any damage to the school property

by the participants or officials accompanying them may be compensated from the security deposit on an actual basis.

7. Once the participating schools enter the school premises (venue), they cannot leave without prior permission from the organisers. Also, written consent would be required from their coaches. Gate Passes will be issued for the same when required.

8. All the teams will retire to their respective rooms and lights to be off by 10:00 pm. loitering around after 10:00 pm and gathering in other rooms will result in strict action against that particular school.

ACCOMMODATION & FOOD

- 1) All outstation teams will be provided campus accommodation, separately for boys and girls. Essential bedding will be provided if intimated in advance.
- 2) Outstation teams will bring a lock with two keys to lock their allotted rooms. One key is to be submitted to the Organizing Secretary after reporting which will be used by cleaning staff and in emergencies.
- 3) Team coaches, managers, and participants shall be provided meals as per the school mess menu at a nominal charge of Rs500/- per head, per day including bedding charges. Meals/snacks would be served as per the scheduled mess timings only. Team Manager should purchase food coupon(s) from the 'Registration Counter' at the time of registration.
- 4) The schools will operate refreshment stalls where students can buy water bottles, juices and other eatable items on cash basic.
- 5) All rooms will be under CCTV surveillance 24X7.
